Between technique and poetry, Éloïse and her Cyr wheel invent a duet dance where every movement is guided by centrifugal force. Almost hypnotic, the act is infused with the artist's radiant smile, as she finds within the spiral the perfect gestures and graceful motion.

Technical requirements and special arrangements

- **Stage space:** minimum 6-meter diameter, with a smooth, flat, and clean floor.
- A heated dressing room for preparation, equipped with one table and one chair per performer, access to running water, and catering (drinks and snacks).
- Please provide the necessary meals for each performer on the day of the performance.
